Set amidst 3,000 acres of beautifully landscaped property, Hudson Farm offers one of the most attractive shooting layouts in the country. They can promise you a spectacular day of shooting clays for all levels of shooters. Hudson Farm's extensive 19-station fully electronic sporting clay course was built with the wing shooter in mind. The sporting clay course was designed to simulate every type of bird hunting situation. Take your shot at simulated driven grouse, high flying pheasants in open fields from a tower and flushing grouse and woodcock in thick woodlands. The course offers experienced and novice shooters an equally challenging and rewarding experience.

Directions

1-80 (West or East depending) Get off at exit 25 (Newton-Stanhope Rd). Follow signs for Rt. 206 North, Lackawanna Drive (across from Barone's Restaurant). Proceed for 2 miles (Lake Lackawanna will be on your right). At stop sign bear right and continue through tunnel for 1.4 miles. When you come to the flashing yellow light turn left and Hudson Farm is 0.3 miles on the right.
