Participants need to arrive by 7:00 pm both nights. Both nights are mandatory to receive credit for course. Each evening will run at least three hours. Coffee and tea will be available and the participants will get to cook their own dinner on the 2nd evening. Classes will start promptly at 7pm.

Equipment needed
