- 1) Explanation of need for assistance
- 2) Applicant Information
 - a. Number of siblings in the household
 - b. Number of siblings in Scouting including applicants
 - c. Applicant's Scouting rank and level of activity in Scouting
 - d. Number of siblings attending college
- 3) Parental involvement in Scouting
- 4) Additional information that may assist in our decision (optional)

As a guideline, the level of assistance available will be 50% of the cost of one week of camp excluding high adventure.
