DIRECTIONS TO THE PRINCETON ELKS LODGE, 2 STATE HIGHWAY 518, BLAWENBURG, NJ 08504:

FROM ROUTE 27 IN PRINCETON: Take Rte 206 North and make a left onto Rte 518. Continue on Route 518 until you pass over the intersection of Great Road (Route 601). Continue about a quarter of mile. You will see a larger red colored building on your left; that is the Elks Lodge.

FROM THE CNJC COUNCIL SERVICE CENTER: Take Route 1 South; make the first right onto Ridge Road. The road name changes to Heathcote Road, then to Laurel Avenue. Continue a total of 3.2 miles, until you reach Route 518. Make a left onto Route 518, travel about 4.5 miles, past Route 206 and The Great Road (Route 601), where you will see the Elks Lodge on your right.

FROM FLEMINGTON: Take Route 202 South for 6.4 miles. Take the ramp on the right for Route 31 towards Trenton, and travel about 4 miles on Route 31 to Route 518. Take Route 518 approximately 6.5 miles; the Elks Lodge will be on your left just before reaching The Great Road (Route 601).

FROM ROUTE 287: Take Exit 10; merge onto Easton Avenue toward New Brunswick. Make a right turn onto Cedar Grove Lane, and take it for 3.1 miles until the end. Make a slight right on to Amwell Road; take for 5.9 miles to Route 206. Make a left turn on to Route 206, 2.6 miles then bear right at Route 601. Take Route 601 for 5.4 miles to Route 518, make a right turn on to Route 518, and the Elks Lodge is on your right.
